## **STATE AND FEDERAL DESIGNATED HISTORIC PROPERTIES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BURNET**

The following properties are designated either by the State of Texas or by the Register of Historic Places as historical properties.

- Airy Mount – Hwy. 29 East (currently the Airy Mount B&B)
- Badger Building – corner of East Jackson and Pierce Street
- Burnet Bulletin – 101 E. Jackson - corner of South Main and East Jackson (currently the offices of Dr. Brian Kingsford)
- Burnet County Courthouse – 220 S. Pierce (National historic marker) Courthouse square
- Burnet County Jail – corner of Washington and Pierce (northeast corner of courthouse square) currently used for County offices.
- Masonic Lodge – 309 S. Main (Oldest commercial building in Burnet)
- Magill Family Cemetery- Burnet Municipal Airport
- Cook Home – 200 N. Main Street (private residence)

- Fort Croghan – 703 W. SH 29 (Museum and grounds, Vanderveer cabin and powder house) See [www.fortcroghan.org](http://www.fortcroghan.org) for schedules.
- Galloway House – 108 E. League, currently the Verandas B&B
- Rocky Rest – 404 S. Water (private residence)
- Russell/McFarland Home – 309 N. Boundary (private residence)
