<u>CALL TO ORDER</u>: The meeting was called to order by Board President Cary Johnson at 3:00 p.m. and quorum was established.

CONSENT AGENDA:

Approval of the June 21, 2022 BEDC Regular Meeting minutes:

Board Member Wayne Brown moved to approve the consent agenda as presented. Board Member Brad Zehner seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

ACTION ITEMS:

<u>Discuss and consider action: BEDC/Chamber of Commerce Committee:</u> Board Member Philip Thurman presented a suggestion to the Board to appoint a committee to join forces with representatives of the Chamber of Commerce to work together in promotion of the City. Director of Public Works/Development Services Carly Pearson said that she would prepare a presentation for the next board meeting outlining best practices for this type of joint effort. No action taken.

<u>Discuss</u> and <u>consider action</u>: <u>Related to the potential sale of all or portions of the Crossings at 281 South Commercial Park</u> Board Member David Vaughn updated all present on the Hotel Study. A report is expected the end of August. Inquiries on the property continue and all interested parties have received a copy of the covenants. No action taken,

Discuss and consider action: Related to the sale of all or portions of the Eastside Commercial Park located on Highway 29 East: Board Member David Vaughn informed all present that negotiations on the Coke Street property are continuing with the representative from the Fickett Estate. Engineering services will be needed to ensure proper alignment with existing roadways if the property is able to be purchased. Mr. Vaughn reported that there is still interest from Louis Johnson in the Eastside Commercial Park. Mr. Johnson has received a copy of the covenants and the board will be updated of any progress in the possible sale. No action taken.

<u>Discuss and consider action: Proposed 2022/2023 Fiscal Year Burnet Economic Development Corporation budget:</u> All present were provided a copy of the proposed 2022-2023 FY budget. Board Member David Vaughn reviewed the proposed budget and answered questions. No action was taken.
